Say

If we hear what someone says, or read a book by someone or about someone, it tells us lots of things. It may tell us about the life of a person, why they are the way they are or what motivates them. It shows the kind of things they like, the way they act and the true person behind the mask. If we read a book, we get to know the author. And if we know and like the author, we may want to read the book.

The Bible is not just lots of made up stories. It's about history and has many historical facts accurately written down. It talks a lot about different people, their problems, faults and successes. Sometimes it's a bit gory and sometimes it says things that people don't like. But most importantly it points to the author of the book. If we want to know an author, we can start by reading a book by them. That is true of the Bible. If we want to know more about God we can read the Bible – or take a look at the life of Jesus.

So here's the basics about the author of the Bible – if you read the book, you can get to know the author. Christians believe the Bible contains God's words which are relevant for everyone, everywhere at every time of history. Because Christians believe that the Bible isn't just history, it is 'His – story' (God's story). And it's for everyone that wants to read it.
